b. Intelligence

(1) During this reporting period the R.20 Bn composed of the R.21 Co,

R.22 Co, R.23 Co, and R.24 Co dominated most of the VC movements within the southern TAOR. A substantial shifting of VC occurred within the area bounded by AT 9152, AT 9557, and AT 9552 with headquarters units located in Hoa Nam and Giac Thuy. Increased VC troop activity was reported in the area bounded by AT 8658, AT 9058, and AT 9054, with two to four VC Bns possibly involved. These units had a large number of civilian porters reportedly moving large quantities of mortar ammunition into the hill mass from AT 8460 to AT 9166.

(2) The effect of the 12th Marines harassment and interdiction (H&I) fires has reportedly increased considerably. Two notable H&I's were 15 VC KIA by one round and 7 VC KIA by another. Agents from the southern TAOR have reported considerable concern on the part of the VC about increased H&I casualties. This has been evidenced by increased civilian groups protesting H&I fires. As these protestors are organized, controlled, and enforced by the VC, their appearance is an indicator as to the H&I fires' good effect on targets.

(3) Crater analysis teams were employed twice during the recent struggle force conflict in Da Nang. Both incidents were ARVN/VNAF originated.

(4) No intelligence training was conducted during this period.

(5) Lack of aircraft prevented adequate aerial observation of the TAOR. At most the 12th Marines received two flights a day. Of the thirteen hours of available daylight it is presently possible to have artillery aerial observers airborne three to four hours. In addition, many flights have been cancelled leaving many days with no artillery aerial observation at all. This situation has hampered the intelligence gathering capability of this Headquarters.

c. Civil Affairs

(1) On 4 May 1966, the Commanding Officer, 12th Marine Regiment was designated as the Civic Action Coordinator of units located within the villages of Hoa Minh, Hoa Khank, and Hoa Phat. The units were assigned hamlets, within the above named villages, for Civic Action work.

(2) English classes of three (3) nights a week are continuing in the hamlet of Da Son (AT 963762).

(3) The weekly movie in the same hamlet has become a day that the people look forward to.

d. ISO

(1) The 12th Marines had 202 Fleet Home Town News Releases during the month of May.

e. Training. During the month of May the regiment continued to conduct

F.O. Schools for 3d Recon small unit leaders. Several units attended Land Mine Warfare School hosted by 3d Engr Bn. One half of the Regiment's Battery Commanders and Executive Officers attended Field Fortification School hosted by 3d Engineer Bn. The Division Communication Equipment Waterproofing course was hosted at the Twelfth Marines command post. All units participated. All units participated in the Motor Vehicle Equipment Waterproofing course hosted at the Ninth Motor Transport Bn. Remainder of training effort was directed toward taking advantage of all available school quotas and improving the forward observer and gunnery procedures through training by the individual battalions.

f. Communications

(1) During this reporting period, the following has been accomplished to improve the overall regimental communication system. Improvements in the communication center consisted of the following: An off-line crypto center vault has been constructed and is nearly ready for operation. Special racks have been installed for the on-line crypto equipment to help improve the heat problem. The crypto repair shop has shelves installed on the bulkheads for storage of test equipment. A covered circuit has been installed between this headquarters and 4th Battalion. Improvements in the wire system are progressing in a new frame test station located within the wire bunker^{W464} is nearly completed. Due to the loss of the radio relay shot between 4th Battalion and Lima Battery, a shot was established with AN/TRC-27 equipment but did not prove very successful due to the lack of sufficient generators and equipment failures. This shot had to be discontinued and emphasis is now placed in getting wire lines installed to replace the radio relay shot.

(2) Staff visits were made to all artillery units in the DaNang and Phu Bai enclaves. Extensive ground reconnaissance has been accomplished in anticipation of proposed movements of artillery units. Maximum effort to use existing wire lines and police of the wire system is continuing.
