### NATRATIVE SUMMARY

On 9 May, 1967, a platoon of 155mm Guns was detected for duty in Support of Operation Cumberland. The platoom set up in Gia Le, 3rd Engineers compound at (YD 829153). On 14 May, 1967, a platoom of M109's from Lima Battery, 4thBn, 12th Marines came under open of the 155mm Gun platoon at Gia Le.

During the month of May, the battery under went a large reorganisation of the defensive positions and defensive counter-attack plans.

Many new bunkers were constructed, along with an extensive wire laying effort. The drills for mortar and/or ground attack have been

revised to enable the battery to react under all possible conditions.

The flash-bang tower was completed during this reporting period and
is manned by the Fire Direction personnel 24 hours per day.

The battery had 8 hours of formal GMS classes this nonth. These classes were held on the M-16 rifle (2 hrs), NCO leadership (1 hr), First Aid, heat casualties (1 hr), Personal Response (1 hr), Basic Communications (1 hr), NBC Defense (1 hr), and a Vietnam orientation class (1 hr). In addition to the GMS classes, the battery had a FAM fire with the M-16 for 25% of our personnel. On the job training was held by all sections to further enable the battery to maintain its combat efficiency.

During this period the battery ran 7 patrols and put out 16
Listening posts.

- 3. Mintenance. During the period a numed out main engine generator was replaced on one Gun, 155mm (SP), M-55, while a quarterly preventive maintenance service was performed on another while undergoing transmission repairs.
- 4. Food Services. The has been a major problem due to the increased water consumption during the hot weather.
- 5. Buckers & Perineter Security. During this period the battery lost the Simm mortar used for illumination of the perimeter. This has led to a delay of from 2-5 minutes for illumination of the perimeter. The battery built serveral more local security bunkers and individual fighting holes. A major effort was made to improve all facets of the defensive perimeter.
- 6. Water. The battery continues to truck water from the division water point.
