NARRATIVE SUMMARY

On 16 September, Captain M. M. BAIG was relieved of command by Major N. J. BECKMAN.

The lat Platoon of the battery displaced on 9 September to (YD 829151) to support the withdrawal from Operation CUMBERLAND.

During the month the battery continued to improve its defensive positions. One new bunker was built. The wire defenses were improved by reinforcing and adding to the present wire between the battery's position and Highway 1. The battery ran 8 night patrols, 4 day patrols and 7 listening post.

During the period of 17-22 September the Commanding General's inspection team inspected the different battery functions. The battery was found to be satisfactory.

GMS and on-the-job training continued throughout the month.

(1) <u>General</u>. During this period the battery remained ADGON/OPGON of 4th Battalion, 12th Marines.

(3) <u>Maintenance</u>. During this period the battery maintenance section improved on 1st and 2nd echelon PM techniques. One tube is being replaced on a 155mm Gun; the battery continued to have difficulty with the weapons sight mounts. One weapon is deade lined at FLSG-A for equilibration problems.

(h) <u>Bunkers and Perimeter Security</u>. During the month of September, one (1) new bunker was constructed. A continued wire laying effort has resulted in a network of wire designed to both impede and channelize the enemy.

(5) <u>Water</u>. The battery continues to truck water from the Division water point.

f. <u>Civic Action</u>. During this period the battery completed a wash rack, acquired fourteen rice machines, and furnished crayons and pencils to two schools at our project village LOC BON. Our Med-Gap treated 1354 people.

g. Administration. The battery is ADCON 4th Battalion, 12th Marines.

- 260750H Sep67 Fired 27 155mm Gun HE on suspected Viet Cong Battalion vic YC 954962, 928967. Mission unobserved, Fire Mission foe 3d Marine Division.
- 261110H Sep67 Fired 12 155mm Gun HE on suspected Viet Cong YD 836010. Negative surviellance. Fire Mission for 3d Recon Battalion.
- 280200H Sep67 Fired 43 155mm Gun HE and 25 155mm Gun WP on North Vietnamese Army Battalion vic YD 72051290. Battery accredited with 25 probable Viet Cong KIA's and 3 secondary explosions. Fire Mission for 3d Recon Battalion.
- 280330H Sep67 Fired 47 155mm Gun HE on North Vietnamese Army Battalion vic YD 717127 Battery credited with 40 probable Viet Cong KIA's. Many secondary explosions observed. Fire Mission for 3d Recon Battalion.
