



#### NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During the period 1-11 October, all sections of the battery were brought together and occupied a position on Hill 34. While at this position, the battery continued preparations for embarkation. On the nights of 10 and 11 October, the battery displaced from Hill 34 to Deep Water Pier, Danang, RVN for staging prior to boarding ship.

On 12 October, the battery embarked aboard the USS Juneau LPD 10, and at approximately 0200 on 13 October; sailed for CONUS.
