## NARRATIVE SUMMARY

The period covered was highlighted by the redeployment of the battery from RVN to MCB Twentynine Palms and subsequent measures taken to return the battery to operational status. On 12 October the unit embarked aboard the USS Juneau (LPD 10) which sailed for CONUS on 13 October.

On 30 October the USS Juneau docked at Long Beach, Calif where the battery personnel were immediately bussed to MCB Twentynine Palms. During the next week all battery supplies and Motor Transport wehicles were shipped to MCB Twentynine Palms under the supervision of 1st Field Artillery Group personnel. The tracked vehicles arrived at the base during the period 17-25 November.

Since 30 October the unit has unloaded and made inventory of all battery equipment. The battery is also in the process of having LTIs performed on all vehicles for condition coding, preparing a budget (concentrating on combat essential items), rewriting orders for garrison operation, and acquiring necessary equipment for both the battery and supply offices.

Accomplishment of these tasks has been hampered by a severe shortage of personnel. Limited funding has also made it necessary to limit our activity only to those requirements imposed by higher headquarters.
